Instructions

Please read this manual carefully before using your telescopic ladder.

PREPERATION

- 1. Ensure that you are fit enough to use the ladder. Certain medical conditions or medication, alcohol or drug abuse could make using the ladder unsafe.
- 2. When transporting ladders on roof bars or in a truck, ensure, they are secured to prevent damage
- 3. Inspect the ladder after delivery; make sure the ladder is in order and safe to use
- 4. Inspect ladder before every use
- 5. Never use a damaged ladder
- 6. Always make sure the ladder is clean before using it. Wipe off all wet paint, mud, snow, oil etc.
- 7. Carry out a risk assessment

POSITIONING AND CORRECTING THE LADDER

- 1. Inclination should not exceed a 75-degree angle
- 2. Position ladder on even and unmovable base. Never on a slippery surface.
- 3. Lean ladder only against flat, robust, and tall objects. If necessary, tie to object for extra stability
- 4. Identify any electrical risks in the work area, such as overhead lines or other exposed electrical equipment
- 5. Avoid any collision. Stay clear from doors and windows. Never block a fire exit with your ladder. Be careful about cars and other vehicles when using ladders outdoors
- 6. Only stand the ladder on its feet never rungs or other parts

USING THE LADDER


- 1. Never exceed maximum load. Always bear additional weight of tools and equipment in mind
- 2. Do not over reach. Shoulders should always stay inside the stiles and both feet on the same rung.
- 3. Do not step off a leaning ladder at a higher level without additional security, such as tying off or use of a suitable stability device
- 4. Do not stand on top 3 steps of a leaning ladder
- 5. Use ladders for light use only. Use only for short duration
- 6. Do not use ladder outside in severe weather conditions (e.g. wind)
- 7. Do not let children play with ladder unattended
- 8. Face ladder when climbing and ascending
- 9. Never use ladder as a bridge
- 10. Wear appropriate footwear when on ladder
- 11. Avoid excessive side loading (e.g. drilling brick and concrete)
- 12. Take regular breaks. Tiredness can be a severe risk
- 13. Leaning ladders used for access to a higher level should be extended at least 1m above the landing point
- 14. Equipment carried while using a ladder should be light and easy to handle.




OPENING THE LADDER

Automatic locking: every rung of your ladder has two locking pins on either side.

- Unlocked: There is a gap between the button and the Span
- Locked position: The buttons are directly on the leg
